The Common Sense of a Legacy: Conceptual Analysis and Civic Engagement starting from Mario Jori

Abstract: The book on *Studi di filosofia analitica del diritto per Mario Jori*, edited by Anna Pintore and Silvia Zorzetto, brilliantly shows how to receive a legacy. Within these essays, a movement is present, that has something to do with the meaning, the direction and the energy of a teaching, with gaining a legacy and with the recognition of a common origin and of a symbolic debt. I have been focused, in particular, on three moments of this movement. The first one concerns the way through which Jori received his master's legacy, Uberto Scarpelli. The second one regards the strict link between the need for a conceptual clarification and the civic engagement. The third one is related to the importance of the irreverence for the ideas. All this on the background of an idea that is constant within Jori's works: the centrality of the common sense for the individuation of law.
